Program Policies

All programs are offered on a first come, first served basis. Dartmouth Recreation reserves the right to cancel any program that does not meet sufficient enrollment. Please register at least one week prior to the start of class to avoid possible program cancellation.

Program Course Confirmation

No confirmations are sent out. A participant is registered when payment is received. We will *only* notify you if there are any problems.

Payment

Payment is due at the time of registration by check or money order ONLY made payable to the Town of Dartmouth. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any check returned for insufficient funds.

Refunds

No refunds will be given unless class is cancelled.

Program Location
