Course Descriptions:

Jewelry Design

Grades 3 and up

This one-week workshop will explore basic jewelry making techniques such as cutting, forming, basic soldering, and finishing. We will also experiment with fused glass. We will create jewelry using a beads, fused glass, copper, nu-gold, and sterling silver. All materials will be supplied. Students who have participated in previous years are welcome to continue building their skills by working on advanced techniques such as soldering

Grade 7 and Up

Develop drawing skills to produce excellent examples of work that may be included in your portfolio for college admission. Through guided practice, sharpen your observational skills as you translate what you see into awesome drawings. Perspective, value, line quality, form, gesture, composition, and proportion will be stressed. Students will learn to draw still life and the figure. All materials are included.
