ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOLS

It is the policy of the Dartmouth School Committee to work to insure that all of Dartmouth's students receive comparable educational opportunities, access to learning resources and participation in classes of reasonable size/number.

Resident students in Grades K-5 are to be assigned to schools within the district attendance zones in which they live.

The Committee recognizes, however, that parents may wish to have their child attend another elementary school located outside of their school attendance zone. In these cases and in light of the educational research that supports reasonable class sizes and as few school changes as possible, all requests will be considered on a space available basis, first-come, first-served basis.
