ELIGIBILITY:

Only those persons meeting the following criteria will be considered for substitute teaching positions:

- Those who have acquired a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university or completed two full years of study at an accredited college or university.
- Those who are of sound moral character as evidenced through background and reference checks.

COMPENSATION:

The compensation schedule for substitute teachers is outlined below:
